As a responsible member of the VET community, AAAT follows a Code of Conduct which outlines how you can expect the organisation and our staff to behave. Similarly, AAAT has expectations for student behaviour.

When undertaking an AAAT course we ask the participants to be courteous to our staff.

AAAT's Code of Conduct Statement

AAAT will not tolerate misconduct under any circumstance and a student's course may be cancelled with no refund if a breach does occur.

Other circumstances which may result in a student's course being cancelled

These include:

- Making a false declaration.

- Conduct that brings AAAT into disrepute or slander of AAAT or staff.
- Plagiarising material, cheating, copying work from another student, use of Augmented Intelligence (AI) to answer assessments.
- Abuse to any member of our staff including verbal or threatening comments or gestures.
- Discrimination, harassment (of any sort), disorderly conduct, disruptive, abusive or anti-social behaviour.
- Behaviour that breaches privacy.
